K-12 Outreach Supporting Careers in Entrepreneurship and Technology:

Preparing the next generation of entrepreneurs and technology leaders, you helped us collaborate with K-12 education partners to host quarterly Stepping into Girls Who Code events for 5th to 8th grade girls to meet tech mentors and enjoy computer science activities, a Tech Career Discovery Series for all career levels, and the STEM Stars Celebration to recognize outstanding STEM educators in our region.

Community Education & Networking Events: Community Partners like you contributed to more than 40 educational and networking events attended by more than 900 people, focused on the latest trends and best practices in cybersecurity, ChatGPT, business finance, and startup operations. Our new digital Access to Capital Guide provides an overview of funding options for each stage of business. These resources served more than 90 companies who are part of the 20Fathoms ecosystem and helped create 37 new tech jobs for our region in 2023.

Pitch Perfect: Through our monthly pitch coaching sessions called Pitch Perfect, a panel of mentors like you provided startup founders with valuable feedback to help them prepare for pitch competitions and investor meetings. In 2024, your support will help us relaunch the TCNewTech pitch competition and expand our wrap-around services for pitch presenters.
